**Using Sabian Symbols
& Guessing the Ascendant Sign**

STEP 1: CREATE & SAVE TWO CHARTS

STEP 2: LIST ZODIACAL DEGREES OF SUN, MOON, MERCURY, VENUS, MARS

Chart A (12:00AM)

☉ Sun	8 Ari 10' 55"
☾ Moon	3 Ari 35' 41"

♀ Venus	3 Ari 22' 13"
♂ Mars	5 Ari 39' 37"

Sun, Moon, and Inner planets are the fastest-moving. So in a 24-hour time range (the entire day of birth), these natal planets change Zodiacal degrees.

Either Sun, Moon, Mercury could be (2) Zodiac signs throughout the day of birth. Pick the sign that suits the native (Sun Sign cusp, for example).

For example: If someone's birth date had Moon transiting from Virgo to Libra during their day of birth, decide if the person is more of a Moon Virgo or Moon Libra... Then do rectification work with the hours of Moon Libra.

Chart B (11:59PM)

In this case of "Aries Stellium," however, all the planets remain in their same signs. Only their degrees had changed, through 12:00 AM to 11:59 PM.

DEGREES OF "ARIES STELLIUM" NATIVE

- Make sure your listing includes every degree.
- The following planetary degrees are transited throughout the date of March 29, 1949...
- **SUN:** Aries 8, 9
- **MOON:** Aries 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15
- **MERCURY:** Pisces 23, 24, 25
- **VENUS:** Aries 3, 4
- **MARS:** Aries 5, 6

By using Sabian Symbols (Degree Symbols), we can pinpoint the degree combination of this Native's personal planets.

Depending on what hour and minute you choose for time of birth, one degree from each set will be present in the chart.

STEP 3: READ SABIAN SYMBOLS

Read all of the Sabian Symbols for every single degree listed.

But first, round each degree to the next degree...

Reflect or meditate on which Sabian Symbols sound the most like the **person** you are rectifying a time-of-birth for.

“Aries Stellium” Chart Example:

Chart A - So we have Sun Aries 8*10', now it becomes Sun Aries 9

Aries 9, Sabian Symbol: “A crystal gazer.”

Chart B - Or we have Sun Aries 9*10', now it becomes Sun Aries 10

Aries 10, Sabian Symbol: “A teacher gives new symbolic forms to traditional images.”

Deciding on 1-of-2 degrees of the Sun, will help determine if the native is born between 12:00AM to sometime in the early afternoon, or afternoon to night time.

SABIAN SYMBOLS & PLANETARY SIGNIFICANCES

- **Sun – Self, personality**
- Sun's Sabian Symbol must describe [or] somehow remind you of the Native.

- **Moon – Psyche, emotional expression**
- Moon's Sabian Symbol must describe [or] abstractly resemble the Native.

- **Mercury – Mind, intellect, mental abilities**
- Mercury's Sabian Symbol must describe [or] represent how the Native thinks of themselves.

- **Venus – Capacity to love, what makes one beautiful**
- Venus' Sabian Symbol must describe [or] reflect how the Native shows love to others, or what their self-love is like.

- **Mars – Strength, temperament**
- Mars' Sabian Symbol must describe [or] be proof of how the Native empowers themselves.

STEP 4: GUESSING ASCENDANT SIGN

If you feel deciding upon the Sabian symbol for each planet is difficult...
You can guess the Native's Ascendant / Rising Sign.

If you sense the Native is a certain Rising sign, read up the Sabian symbols of that exact Zodiac sign (for the Ascendant / Rising).

Every Ascendant, with some clues:

Aries – Bold, assertive, youthful

Taurus – Stubborn, content, patient

Gemini – Talkative, humorous, know a bit of everything

Cancer – Caring, temperamental, love for one's household

Leo – Friendly, varying levels of self-esteem (usually positive & healthy)

Virgo – Analytical, understanding, devoted to one's routines

Libra – Considerate towards loved ones, relaxed, sociable

Scorpio – Mysterious at first, but feelings are of great depth (for better or worse)

Sagittarius – Swings from being carefree to philosophically pondering.

Capricorn – Serious, a little sarcastic, has a hidden "soft" nature.

Aquarius – Can either care a lot or not, reserved- but comfortable around some.

Pisces – Day-dreamer, seems to have peace of mind (but may or may not).

SABIAN SYMBOLS & ANGULAR SIGNIFICANCES

- Ascendant (A.C.) - Represents “**WHO**” the Native is
- Descendant (D.C.) – Represents “**WHAT**” direction or “**WHERE**” the Native is going in their life
- Imum Coeli (I.C.) – Represents “**HOW**” the Native develops towards it [or] gets there.
- Midheaven (M.C.) – Represents “**WHY**” the Native is living this lifetime now.

STEP 5: CONSIDER HOUSE PLACEMENTS

Once you completed choosing the most fitting Sabian symbols...
[OR] Have guessed the Ascendant sign that most resembles the Native
[OR] Completed BOTH Ascendant and Sabian Symbol selection(s)...

You can now officially work with the Whole Sign Houses (or Placidus)

Keep changing the time of birth on your Native's www.Astro.com profile... Then keep looking at house positions of the planets.

Soon enough, you will have a hypothetical Natal chart.

If your intuition is strong enough, as well as your knowledge of both astrology and the Native (the person you're rectifying a time of birth for)... Then perhaps you will have configured an approximate (or even accurate) birth time! 😊

Two calculated points that depend on time of birth are the Vertex and Pars Fortunae (Arabic Part of Fortune).

Feeling ambitious? List Pars Fortunae & Vertex degrees throughout the day of birth, and read their Sabian symbols.

Note: You need to make sure "Uranus-Pluto off" is NOT check-marked. As the Part of Fortune & Vertex only appear when all planets are included in the generated chart.

ASPECTS TO THE MOON

Take into consideration all of the possible aspects to the Natal Moon (as throughout the day of birth, the Moon changes degrees very fast).

Reflect on which Natal Moon + Planet Aspect most resembles the Native's behavior or outlook.

(i.e. Moon square Mercury VS Moon not-aspecting Mercury: passive-aggressive with thoughts and feelings [or] just simply emotional.)

ASPECTS TO ASCENDANT

Another way to “guess” an Ascendant sign and its degree, is see if any Natal Planet makes an aspect.

Natal Planets negatively aspecting a possible Ascendant, are clues that may match one’s flaws.

If someone were to try rectifying my time of birth, suppose they think I have Moon trine Ascendant (and they would be correct). As a Moon Gemini, then my Ascendant sign can possibly be Libra or Aquarius.

But to guess like this, requires a heavy understanding of the Native (preferably someone you know well).

ASPECTS TO MIDHEAVEN & SIGN OF THE M.C.

Another approach, is to guess the Midheaven Sign. Even if the following meanings do not “fit” the Native, there are also more specific Midheaven sign interpretations available online and in various books. Choose any sign; read the Sabian symbols

Mutable Signs (Gemini, Virgo, Sagittarius, Pisces)

- Multiple careers; carelessness with work or unemployment; finding joy in one’s profession or work; intellectual or service jobs.

Cardinal Signs (Aries, Cancer, Libra, Capricorn)

- Team-oriented; entrepreneurship; internships; having pride in one’s profession; work that involves discipline or passion.

Fixed Signs (Taurus, Leo, Scorpio, Aquarius)

- Goal-setting; maintenance and stability of one’s preferred lifestyle; having high standards in workplaces; jobs that improve or save lives.

Also consider all possible Natal Planet–Midheaven Aspects.

Midpoint Conjunctions (Optional)

- Midpoints are a meticulous method to work with...
But can be useful for rectification.
- Look for Moon aspects to Midpoints.
- Look for important Moon; Ascendant; Midheaven Midpoints and their possible aspects to Natal Planets.
